Wildflower meadows are among the most important wildlife habitats in the UK, as they support significantly high numbers of plant and animal species. Yet only fragments of them remain nationally. With the loss of diverse flowering plants came an associated decline in bees, butterflies and other insects as well as many birds, bats and small mammals. The good news is that this important habitat can be restored or created - in gardens, on farmland and churchyards and on roadside verges.
